## Tuition and Fees

### Spring 2013

**January 2, 2013** – Last day to pay Spring 2013 tuition and fees. All third party authorizations must be received by this date. If you elect to pay using the installment payment plan(60/40), the first 60% is due by this date and the student must come to the campus Business Office to fill out the form.

**January 3, 2013** – All unpaid students for Spring 2013 will be dropped from their classes at the close of the business day.

**February 25, 2013** – Final 40% of installment payment plan is due.

**Traditional Trimester Classes**

To be eligible for a refund after the beginning day of classes for the term, the student must withdraw from all trimester classes (leaving 0 hours registered for the 15 week term) within the refund dates listed below.

The technology fee and the health/wellness fee are non-refundable as of the first day of classes for any given trimester (academic term). 100% refunds are given for any classes cancelled by the college or for any class that the student withdraws from prior to the beginning day of classes for the academic term.

**Non-Traditional Classes**

Non-Traditional classes are classes that have a shorter duration period than the 15 week trimester classes. 100% refund is given when you drop the class before the first day of the class. No refund beginning the day the class starts.
